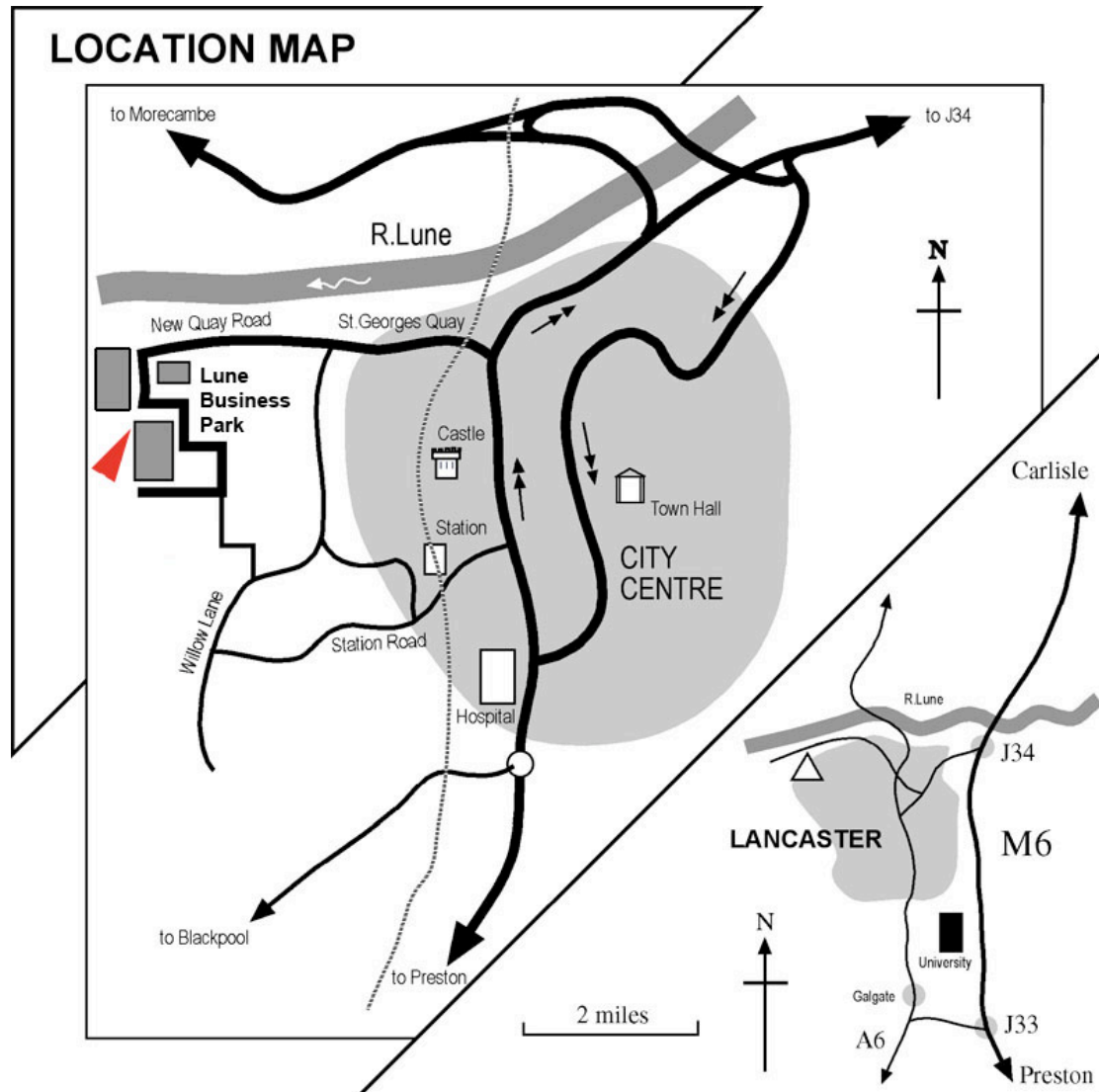


## Directions To: [STS Manufacturing Ltd.](#)

### From the North:

Leave the M6 at J34. Follow signs for the City Centre.

Pass Holiday Inn Hotel and Shell garage (R). Follow the one way system through the city. As you approach the Town Hall (L), keep in the right hand lane then turn right at the traffic island into the left hand lane on King Street. After a third set of traffic lights, at Waterstones bookshop, the road becomes a short, steep hill; take the immediate left turn at the bottom of the hill into \*St. George's Quay, which merges into New Quay Road.

**IF YOU MISS THIS TURNING, YOU WILL HAVE TO GO ROUND THE ONE WAY SYSTEM AGAIN!**

Follow the River Lune almost to the very end of the Quay and turn left into Thetis Road. (Lune Business Park - just after the post boxes on your left hand side). Follow Thetis Road down for 200m and at the first sharp left bend go straight ahead through metal gates. STS Manufacturing offices are on the left.

\*HGV drivers please note, there is a **4 metre height limit** along St. George's Quay.

From the South:

Leave the M6 at J33. Take the A6 North following signs for the City Centre.

Go straight over the roundabout onto South Road, pass Royal Lancaster Infirmary (L), and go straight over the lights into King Street staying in the left hand lane. After a third set of traffic lights, at Waterstones bookshop, the road becomes a short, steep hill; take the immediate left turn at the bottom of the hill into \*St. George's Quay, which merges into New Quay Road.

**THE CITY CENTRE OPERATES ROUND A ONE-WAY SYSTEM, SO IF YOU MISS THIS TURNING, YOU WILL HAVE TO GO ROUND AGAIN!**

Follow the River Lune almost to the very end of the Quay and turn left into Thetis Road. (Lune Business Park - just after the post boxes on your left hand side). Follow Thetis Road down for 200m and at the first sharp left bend go straight ahead through metal gates. STS Manufacturing offices are on the left.

\*HGV drivers please note, there is a **4 metre height limit** along St. George's Quay.
